## ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 7, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Granting Intervention and Directing Filing of Procedural Schedule, directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later The Staff of the Missouri Public Service than January 19, 1999. Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Suspend Filing of the Proposed Procedural Schedule on January 19, 1999. Staff notes that the parties are in the process of negotiating and expect to file a unanimous stipulation and agreement with the Commission. Staff indicates that it believes that a stipulation and agreement will be filed with the Commission no later than February 9. Consequently, Staff requests that the Commission postpone the filing of a procedural schedule until February 9, 1999, to afford the parties an opportunity to reach an agreement, or in the alternative, to file a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that the request is reasonable and should be granted. The procedural schedule shall be suspended until February 9, 1999.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion to Suspend Filing of the Proposed Procedural Schedule filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission on January 19, 1999, is granted, and the procedural schedule is suspended until February 9, 1999, in order to allow the parties time to complete and file a stipulation and agreement.
- 2. That this order shall become effective on January 26, 1999.
