# ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 30, 1999, St. John's Mercy Health System, doing business as St. John's Mercy Hospital (Applicant), a Missouri corporation, filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to provide private shared tenant services (STS) at an office building located at 851 East Fifth Street, Washington, Missouri 63090, and at a hospital located at 200 Madison Street, Washington, Missouri 63090. On April 6, 1999, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) timely filed an application to intervene, which the Commission granted by order issued on April 12, 1999. Also on April 12, 1999, the Commission set a prehearing conference for April 22, 1999, and directed that a joint proposed procedural schedule be filed by April 29, 1999.

On April 22, 1999, the parties filed their joint Motion to Cancel Prehearing Conference. Evidently, the parties are preparing a Stipulation and Agreement, which they hope to file by April 29, 1999. Therefore, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

However, the parties must file either a Stipulation and Agreement or a proposed procedural schedule by April 29, 1999.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the prehearing conference previously set for April 22, 1999, beginning at 10:00 a.m., is canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 23, 1999.
