ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFFS

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion on February 20, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel the interexchange certificate and tariffs of TELNET Communications, Inc. (Telnet) for failure to comply with Missouri law and Commission orders. Staff stated that Telnet had failed to file annual reports as required by statute, had been administratively dissolved by the Missouri Secretary of State, and had not kept the Commission apprised of its current address.

The Commission issued an Order Establishing Case and Giving Notice on February 26, directing that Telnet be given notice of Staff's motion and an opportunity to be heard. Telnet was directed to respond by March 30 to avoid cancellation of its certificate and tariffs without further hearing. Telnet filed no response.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and recommendation, and the official file and finds that the interexchange certificate and tariffs granted to and approved for Telnet in Case No. TA-92-200 shall be canceled for failure to comply with Missouri statutes and the conditions of certification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the interexchange certificate and tariffs granted to and approved for TELNET Communications, Inc. in Case No. TA-92-200 are canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on April 17, 1998.
