PROPOSED LIST OF WITNESSES, ORDER OF WITNESSES, ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION, AND ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS, AND REQUEST TO MODIFY HEARING SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, on its own behalf and on behalf of St. Louis County Water Company d/b/a Missouri-American Water Company, St. Louis County, Missouri, and the Office of the Public Counsel, being all of the parties in this case, and submits to the Missouri Public Service Commission the following Proposed List of Witnesses, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination, and Order of Opening Statements and Request to Modify Hearing Schedule.

- 1. On November 8, 2001, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule. The Commission ordered each party to file a list of the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing and the order in which they shall be called, and ordered the parties to jointly establish the order of cross-examination, by no later than February 8, 2002.
- 2. In lieu of preparing and filing separate lists of witnesses, the parties have jointly assembled a proposed list of witnesses and hereby submit their proposed list of witnesses, order

or witnesses and order of cross-examination. The parties also hereby submit their proposed order of opening statements.

I. ORDER OF WITNESSES

- 3. Staff.

III. ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS

The parties propose that opening statements be presented in the following order:

A. Staff

B. County Water

C. St. Louis County

D. Public Counsel.

3. In its Order Establishing Procedural Schedule, the Commission reserved two days for the evidentiary hearing, as the parties had requested in a Proposed Procedural Schedule, and ordered that the hearing commence at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 21, 2002. After reviewing the testimony, the parties have concluded that only one day will be required for the evidentiary hearing in this case. Furthermore, County Water witness James M. Jenkins will not be available to testify on February 21, but will be available to testify on February 22. The parties therefore jointly request that the Commission modify the Procedural Schedule by canceling the first day of hearing and ordering that the evidentiary hearing commence at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 22, 2002.

WHEREFORE, the parties submit their proposed list of witnesses, order of witnesses, order of cross-examination, and order of opening statements, and request that the Commission modify the procedural schedule by eliminating the first day of the hearing.
