Complainant Proposes Settlement Agreement with mediation from the commission.

To get this over with therefore everyone can be done with this matter I'm offering a proposal to Ameren on the matter. The outline term and conditions will apply.

If Ameren agrees to the email submitted to the PSC and counsel back on June 20, 2023. The terms would be as to this.

If Ameren restores power to premises in the complaint today July 20, or July 21st, 2023. Complainant will pay [REDACTED], paid due, by no later than Wednesday July 26, 2023. The remainder of the balance, minus being charged for winter months and summer months in two months last year, that amount and itemized late fees, reduced, based on new amount due. Funds must be paid by CC or Cashier's Check or money order paid to the party

The remainder of the amount is deferred over a certain number of months, etc that we can agree towards a reasonable payment amount. Paid with CC, Cashiers Check or money order.

The PSC will serve as a liaison or mediator on the issue to make sure payments have been posted and etc, therefore we don't have the problem again. Complainant will report payment to PSC and Ameren will confirm payment has been paid to provider.

In return, complainant will release Ameren from any further liability and will drop any lawsuits within 7 days and give copies of any dismissal of complaints whether lawsuits or outside complaints.

In addition, settlement must be signed and agreed to by all parties.

Again, to get this done and over with, I'm proposing a settlement.

If this commission wants to serve as a mediator to get a possible agreement in place, I would be for that as well. Here's a starting point.
