ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 19, 2015, Neighbors United Against Ameren’s Power Line (“Neighbors United”) filed a Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule. Neighbors United cited the current close of discovery on November 30, 2015, along with Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (“ATXI”) filing surrebuttal on November 16, 2015 from eight new witnesses, as reasons for the motion. Neighbors United asks the Commission to continue the hearing from December 14, 2015 to January 25, 2016.

The Staff of the Commission (“Staff”) and the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”) do not object. ATXI objects, arguing, *inter alia*, the need to build the project to meet a MISO deadline of December, 2018.

The Commission finds Neighbor’s United motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:


1. The Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule filed by Neighbors United Against Ameren’s Power Line is granted.
