ORDER AND NOTICE

On July 10, 2001, The Empire District Electric Company filed a pleading indicating that it has filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) an application to transfer operational control over designated transmission facilities to the Regional Transmission Organization of the Southwest Power Pool. Empire requests that the Commission issue an order finding that it has no jurisdiction over the subject matter of its application to the FERC. In the alternative, Empire requests that the Commission grant its approval of the transfer of operational control if it determines that it does have jurisdiction.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Records Department of the Commission shall send notice to all parties to Empire's most recent rate case. Proper parties wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Copies of the application to intervene should be sent to the parties listed below.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party is granted intervention and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the

Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that the applicants may submit their evidence in support of the application by verified statement.¹

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send notice to all parties to The Empire District Electric Company's most recent rate case.
- 2. That any interested person wishing to intervene in this case shall file an application on or before August 1, 2001, with:
