ORDER APPROVING REPLACEMENT MEMBER OF
RELAY MISSOURI ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Commission, upon implementation of the Missouri Dual Party Relay Service (Relay Missouri), established an Advisory Committee to provide guidance, act on or process and respond to complaints about the service. The committee consists of twelve members, with eight members from the speaking or hearing impaired community. The eight members are recommended by the Missouri Commission for the Deaf (MCD). When a vacancy occurs the MCD recommends a replacement to the Public Service Commission for approval.

By memorandum filed December 3, 1993, Commission Staff indicated that a vacancy on the Advisory Committee has occurred by the resignation of Jane Ross. Staff states that MCD has recommended Robin Hamerdinger as the replacement. Staff recommends the Commission approve this recommendation.

The Commission will approve the membership of Robin Hamerdinger as recommended by MCD and Commission Staff. In addition, the Commission finds that the approval of Advisory Committee replacements is the only purpose for which this docket remains open. This, the Commission believes, can be done administratively. The Commission will therefore close this docket. Future recommendations for approval of Advisory Committee replacements should be placed on the agenda by Staff for Commission approval.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Robin Hamerdinger be hereby approved as a member of the Missouri Dual Party Relay Service Advisory Committee.
2. That this case be hereby closed.
3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
