ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On December 18, 1989, Greeley Gas Company (Company) of Denver, Colorado, submitted to this Commission for approval, a tariff which reflects a change in the wording in Company's current PGA Clause to reflect a change in the billing by its wholesale supplier, Williams Natural Gas Company.

The tariff was filed with a January 17, 1990, effective date in order to allow thirty days notice. On December 19, 1989, Company filed a MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF TARIFF UPON LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS' NOTICE in which it was requested that the tariff be approved to become effective January 1, 1990, in order to more accurately track its wholesale suppliers billing structure.

Staff reviewed the filing and recommended the tariff be allowed to become effective on the expedited effective date of January 1, 1990.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's recommendations and is of the opinion that good cause has been shown and is therefore, of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested expedited effective date of January 1, 1990.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following tariff sheet submitted December 18, 1989, by Greeley Gas Company of Denver, Colorado, for the purpose of reflecting

a change in wording in its current PGA Clause, be, and it is, hereby authorized to become effective on and after January 1, 1990.
