**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

On May 10, 1995, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) filed proposed tariff sheets. This tariff filing has two purposes. One purpose is to introduce a new service offering called Moonlight Madness which is targeted to the college market. This service offers subscribers a rate of \$0.09 per minute from 9:00 p.m. to 8:59 a.m. The second purpose is to grandfather the Option B Calling Plan as of June 1, 1995.

On May 16, 1995, the Commission Staff (Staff) filed its memorandum regarding the proposed tariff sheets. Staff states that it has no objection to the proposed tariff and recommends approval. Staff states that it is unaware of any other filings which would affect or which would be affected by this proposal.

Having reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's memorandum, the Commission determines that the proposed tariff sheets should be approved because this will provide a new service to Missouri customers.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the following tariff sheets filed by Sprint Communications Company L.P. on May 10, 1995, are hereby approved to become effective on June 1, 1995:
