ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On September 5, 1989, American Communications, Inc. (ACI) submitted proposed tariff sheets designed to decrease rates for its Unicall-Plus service and to establish rates, rules and regulations for two new services, 800 America and Open Line-800. The tariffs bear a requested effective date of October 10, 1989.

On September 25, 1989, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum herein recommending that the proposed tariffs be approved. Staff states that it has reviewed the cost data submitted by ACI and determined that the proposed rates recover ACI's cost to provide the services in question.


Based upon the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission determines that the proposed tariffs should be allowed to go into effect on the requested effective date.
