ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On December 11, 1990, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) requested it be allowed to revise its Local Exchange Tariff to accommodate the provision of Community Optional Service (COS) in its Pacific, Missouri exchange. Bell requested that the Commission allow the Company's proposed revised tariff to go into effect with less than 30 days' notice, for an effective date of December 28, 1990, in order to comply with the Commission's November 30, 1990, Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement.

On December 19, 1990, Staff recommended that an Order Approving Tariff be issued.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff revision and the recommendation of its staff and determines the proposed tariff should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed revision on P.S.C. Mo. No. 24, Local Exchange Tariff, 2nd Revised Sheet 43, filed on December 11, 1990 by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is hereby approved.

2. That this order shall become effective on date date hereof.
