ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On March 7, 1991, GTE North, Incorporated (GTE) submitted a tariff proposing to implement community optional service (COS) from its Sturgeon exchange to its Columbia exchange. The implementation of COS on this route is pursuant to the schedule agreed to by the parties to Case No. TO-90-232 for the implementation of Phase II routes. Pursuant to that Stipulation and Agreement, GTE requests that the Commission approve this proposed tariff for service rendered on and after May 1, 1991.

On April 24, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission issue an order approving this proposed tariff. Based upon the foregoing, the Commission determines that this tariff should be approved for service on and after May 1, 1991.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed in this case by GTE North, Incorporated proposing to implement community optional service (COS) from the Sturgeon exchange to the Columbia exchange of GTE be approved hereby for service rendered on and after May 1, 1991.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
