ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 14, 1991, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) submitted a tariff proposing to implement community optional service (COS) from its Ware exchange to the St. Louis metropolitan calling area also served by SWB. The implementation of COS on this route is pursuant to the schedule agreed to by the parties to Case No. TO-90-232 for the implementation of Phase II routes. Pursuant to that Stipulation and Agreement, SWB requests that the Commission approve this proposed tariff for service rendered on and after February 22, 1991.

On January 31, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission issue an order approving this proposed tariff. Based upon the foregoing, the Commission determines that this tariff should be approved for service on and after February 22, 1991.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed in this case by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company proposing to implement community optional service (COS) from its Ware exchange to its St. Louis metropolitan calling area be approved hereby for service rendered on and after February 22, 1991.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
