The Commission finds that the proposed tariff would allow AmeriCall to have tariffs listed under the name by which it now does business. The Commission further finds that it is in the public interest for AmeriCall's tariffs and AmeriCall's corporate name to represent the same entity to the public. Having considered that AmeriCall's proposed tariff is in the public interest and also having considered Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the Adoption Notice whereby AmeriCall would adopt and continue to use the pre-existing

AmeriCall tariffs is just and reasonable. The Commission will approve the proposed tariff for service on and after January 29, 1993.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the following Adoption Notice, submitted on December 30, 1992 by AmeriCall is hereby approved for services on and after January 29, 1993:
