ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

On April 30, 1996, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a proposed tariff sheet designed to extend an operator services promotion through December 31, 1996. The promotion provides discounted toll rates and service charges for customers who place operator station and person-to-person collect calls. AT&T has requested expedited consideration of its proposed tariff sheet.

On May 15, 1996, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve AT&T's proposed tariff sheet. Staff stated that it has no objections to the proposed tariff sheet or to its approval on an expedited basis. Staff also recommended that the tariff sheet be approved at the Commission's earliest convenience.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by AT&T on April 30, 1996 should be approved for service on and after May 24, 1996.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the following tariff sheet filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. is hereby approved for service on and after May 24, 1996:
