ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On April 3, 1990, Teleconnect Company (TC) filed tariffs proposing to increase rates for its "travel service" class of service. TC states that the increase is necessary to recover the embedded cost of the service which is not currently being recovered due to a large number of customers converting from "travel service" to a similar but premium service called USA Card. In addition, the proposed tariffs change the general information section of TC's present tariffs to more accurately reflect its current procedure in passing through taxes legally imposed by various taxing authorities.

The Commission's Staff (Staff) recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariffs for service rendered on and after May 1, 1990. Staff states that all of TC's customers have been issued a new USA Card and that calls made via the USA Card cost less than calls via "travel service" whether at the existing or the proposed rate. Therefore, Staff states that TC subscribers will not be harmed even if the "travel service" rate is increased.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariffs filed herein by Teleconnect Company on April 3, 1990, are approved hereby for service on and after May 1, 1990.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
