ORDER CANCELING SERVICE AUTHORITY

On June 23, 1992, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service to US Intertel Corporation (Intertel). On April 20, 1994, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission cancel Intertel's certificate of service authority. Although no formal request has been filed by Intertel, Staff based its recommendation on its belief that Intertel no longer provides pay telephone service in Missouri.

In its memorandum, Staff states that mail has been returned as undeliverable when sent to the address listed in Intertel's case file. Staff also states that it has attempted to contact Intertel directly and through its attorney, and has checked with the Secretary of State for a new address. Staff indicates that all attempts to contact Intertel have been unsuccessful. Staff believes that Intertel is no longer operational and recommends that the Commission cancel Intertel's certificate of service authority because Intertel no longer provides pay telephone service in Missouri.

Upon review of Staff's memorandum, the Commission finds that Intertel no longer provides pay telephone service in Missouri. Thus, the Commission determines that Intertel's certificate of service authority should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority issued to US Intertel Corporation is hereby canceled.

2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
