ORDER CANCELING SERVICE AUTHORITY

On May 25, 1994, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service to Steve Elliot d/b/a Tamashii Communications Co. (Tamashii). On March 29, 1996, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission cancel Tamashii's certificate of service authority. Although no formal request has been filed by Tamashii, Staff based its recommendation on its belief that Tamashii violated the terms of its certificate.

In its memorandum, Staff stated that the 1995 Statement of Revenue form which the Commission mailed to Tamashii was returned by the post office with no forwarding address. Staff also stated that it attempted to contact Mr. Elliot but discovered that the telephone number listed on Tamashii's application had been reassigned and directory assistance had no new number. Staff recommended that the Commission cancel Tamashii's certificate of service authority based on Staff's belief that Tamashii has violated the terms of its certificate by its failure to keep the Commission informed of its current address and telephone number, and its failure to file an Annual Report and Statement of Revenue form.

Upon review of Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Tamashii has violated the terms and conditions of its certificate of service authority. Thus, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Tamashii should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of service authority granted to Steve Elliot d/b/a Tamashii Communications Co. is hereby canceled.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on May 14, 1996.
