ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On July 19, 1979, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a certificate of service authority to Batson Development Company (Batson) to operate Batson Mini Farms Water Supply and Distribution System. On April 9, 1991, Batson filed an application requesting the Commission approve the sale of Batson Mini Farms Water Supply and Distribution System to Butler County Water Supply District No. 1.

On June 25, 1991, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending the Commission grant the sale of the franchise and cancel the certificate of service authority. On July 3, 1991, the Commission issued its order authorizing the sale of the franchise and determined that the certificate of service should be cancelled after notification by Batson that the transfer had been completed.

On October 17, 1991, Batson filed notification that the sale was completed and that Butler County Supply District No. 1 began operation of the system on October 1, 1991.

The Commission has determined that the certificate of service authority issued to Batson should be cancelled as the transfer has been

completed and Butler County Water Supply District No. 1 began operation of the system on October 1, 1991.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority issued to Batson Development Company be hereby cancelled.
2. That this order shall become effective on December 3, 1991.
