ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On August 2, 1990, the Public Service Commission issued a Report and Order in which a certificate of service authority to provide shared tenant services was issued to St. John's Mercy Hospital (St. John's) of Washington, Missouri. On October 19, 1992, St. John's sent a letter to the Commission requesting that it be allowed to "withdraw its . . . permit." This letter was inadvertently directed to a staff member instead of to the case file. On March 14, 1994, the Commission staff member confirmed with St. John's that it still wished to have its certificate cancelled.


The Commission finds that it is not in the public interest to allow certificates of service authority to continue where they are not warranted or not required. The Commission will grant St. John's request to cancel its certificate of service authority as a shared tenant services provider.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide shared tenant services as issued on August 2, 1990 is hereby cancelled.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 4, 1994.
