In the matter of the application of Sho-Me Power Corporation requesting the Commission to issue its order) finding that it is reasonable and prudent for Sho-Me Power Corporation to be a member of the rural electric cooperative system of the state of Missouri, including membership in Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc., and) for Sho-Me Power Corporation to honor the Electric Power) Coordination Agreement between Associated Electric Coop-) Case No. E0-92-60 erative, Inc., and Sho-Me Power Corporation and for an order approving and adopting a streamlined method of rate regulation for Sho-Me Power Corporation which takes) into consideration Sho-Me Power Corporation's position as an integral part of the REA-financed rural electric cooperative system of the state of Missouri.

ORDER CLOSING CASE

On September 17, 1993, the Commission issued its Report And Order in Case No. EO-93-259 which, inter alia, authorized Sho-Me Power Corporation, now Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative, (Sho-Me) to convert to a Chapter 394, R.S.Mo. 1986, rural electric cooperative. The effective date of the order was October 1, 1993, if Sho-Me paid its unpaid annual assessments. On September 21, 1993, the ordered payments were received and upon the effective date of the Report And Order in Case No. EO-93-259 Sho-Me ceased being regulated by the Commission as a Chapter 393, R.S.Mo. 1986, utility.

On September 29, 1993, the Commission issued its Supplemental Order Canceling Certificate And Tariffs for Sho-Me effective October 1, 1993. A Motion For Rehearing filed by the City of West Plains, Missouri, was denied by the Commission on October 12, 1993.

The Commission determines that its Report And Order in Case No. EO-93-259 has rendered the action herein moot, as its jurisdiction over Sho-Me ended upon Sho-Me's authorized conversion to a Chapter 394 rural electric cooperative. The Commission, therefore, will dismiss this case for the reasons herein stated and close the file.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the action filed herein involving Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative be hereby dismissed.
 - That the case file be closed.
- 3. That this order shall become effective on the 2nd day of November, 1993.
