ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

By its Report and Order issued February 8, 1990, in Cases No. TR-89-182, TR-89-238 and TC-90-75, the Commission created the instant docket for the purpose of developing a workable incentive regulation model for GTE North Incorporated (GTE North). Since creation of the docket several informal conferences have been held in an attempt to arrive at a workable plan.

Counsel for GTE North has now informed the Commission that the Company has no objection to the Commission closing this docket in the event the Commission has a desire to investigate incentive regulation as a general policy consideration.

The Commission concludes, that since the pendency of the instant docket may hinder any desire to investigate incentive regulation as a policy basis, the docket should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Case No. TO-90-180 is hereby closed and no further proceedings shall be held herein.
2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
