

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE**  
**TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT OUT OF TIME**

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

On June 5, 2000, INTELLICALL OPERATOR SERVICES, INC. (INTELLICALL), filed a Motion for Leave to File Annual Report Out of Time, requesting that its annual report, which was filed along with the motion, be accepted for filing out of time. INTELLICALL states that the 1999 annual report was due on April 17, 2000,<sup>1</sup> and that INTELLICALL initially submitted the annual report for filing on or about April 21, 2000. As the report was not timely filed, it was rejected. In its June 5, 2000, motion, INTELLICALL notes that the annual report had been prepared for filing by its accountants, but that certain key individuals in the approval route were out of the office at critical times. Additionally, the potential for a strategic acquisition consumed human

resources that otherwise would have been focused on preparation of annual reports. INTELLICALL indicates that the delay was not intentional or designed to purposely violate the rules of the Commission, and that allowing the late filing of the annual report would not be detrimental to the public interest.


The Commission finds that good cause exists to permit INTELLICALL to file its annual report out of time, and the Commission will grant the company's request to extend the filing date for the annual report.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion for Leave to File Annual Report Out of Time, filed on June 5, 2000, by INTELLICALL OPERATOR SERVICES, INC., is granted. The annual report deadline requirement of 4 CSR 240-10.080 is waived, permitting the filing of INTELLICALL OPERATOR SERVICES, INC.'S 1999 annual report on June 5, 2000.
2. That this order shall become effective on June 29, 2000.
3. That this case may be closed on June 30, 2000.


