# ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On December 3, 1999, UtiliCorp United, Inc. (UtiliCorp), filed an application with the Commission requesting authority to act through its Brazilian subsidiary, UtiliCorp Brazil Energy Holdings, through a bid process, to acquire the capital stock of Compania Energetia De Pernambuco (CELPE). CELPE is a state-owned electric utility located in Brazil. Due to the bidding timetable for the transaction, UtiliCorp has requested the Commission's action on its application by January 21, 2000.

In order to allow time for the Commission's consideration of the recommendation by the Commission's Staff and a response from the Office of the Public Counsel, if any, the Commission will provide filing deadlines. The Staff will be ordered to file its recommendation no later than January 14, 2000. Any filing concerning the application by the Office of the Public Counsel or any other party shall be filed by the same date.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission file its recommendation concerning the application of UtiliCorp United, Inc., no later than January 14, 2000.
- 2. That the Office of the Public Counsel and any other party wishing to respond to the application shall do so no later than January 14, 2000.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 17, 1999.
