ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

TON Services, Inc. (TON), applied to the Public Service Commission on August 26, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440, RSMo 1994¹. TON asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. TON is a Utah corporation, with its principal office located at 4185 Harrison Boulevard, Suite 301, Ogden, Utah 84403.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications for Intrastate Certificates of Service Authority and Opportunity to Intervene on August 31, 1999, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by September 15, 1999. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked

permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

TON filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application with an effective date of October 11, 1999. TON's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies TON as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. TON intends to provide interexchange telecommunications services including debit card services.

In its Memorandum filed on September 23, 1999, the Staff of the Commission recommended that the Commission grant TON a certificate of service authority, competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff to become effective on October 11, 1999.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange telecommunications market is in the public interest and TON should be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services TON proposes to offer are competitive and TON should be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that TON's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer. The Commission

finds that the proposed tariff filed on August 26, 1999 should be approved to become effective on October 11, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That TON Services, Inc., is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 2. That TON Services, Inc., is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:
