ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

Worldwide Fiber (Applicant), filed Networks, Inc. an application to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and for competitive classification on September 1, 1999. Along with its application, Applicant submitted a proposed tariff with an effective date of October 18, 1999. On September 7, 1999, the Commission issued a Notice and Schedule of Applicants requiring that applications to intervene be filed no later than September 22, 1999. This notice stated that Applicant had requested a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and classification as a competitive company with the standard waivers.

On September 24, 1999, Applicant filed an amendment to its application, indicating that it also wishes to request a certificate of authority to provide local exchange telecommunications service, limited to the provisioning of dedicated, non-switched local exchange private line services. Applicant states that it incorporates by reference its previous application and appendices.

The Commission has reviewed Applicant's amendment to its application and has determined that proper parties should be given

notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. As the previous Notice of Applicants indicated that Applicant was applying for certificate of service authority to provide intrastate а interexchange telecommunications services only, а new Notice of Applications must be issued regarding Applicant's additional request for a certificate of service authority to provide local exchange telecommunications service. Therefore, in order to allow notice and an opportunity for interested parties to intervene, the proposed tariff sheets will be suspended for a period of 30 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed tariff sheets filed by Worldwide Fiber Networks, Inc., on September 1, 1999, (tariff file number 200000192), are suspended for a period of 30 days beyond October 18, 1999, to November 17, 1999, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission:
