## ORDER SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On April 5, 1999, Osage Water Company filed an application pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 1994, requesting that the Commission grant it a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a water and sewer system for the public located in an unincorporated portion of Camden County known as Eagle Woods. On April 28, 1999, the City of Osage Beach filed a timely application to intervene which was granted on May 11, 1999.

On June 24, 1999, the Commission entered its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule which, inter alia, set an evidentiary hearing for December 2 and 3, 1999.

The Commission, on its own motion, will schedule a local hearing in this matter. The Records Department of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the mayors of all municipalities located within Camden County and to the county commission of Camden County. The

Information Office of the Commission shall send notice to the members of the General Assembly who represent Camden County, and to the newspapers, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri, that serve Camden County.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a local public hearing shall be held on September 16, 1999, beginning at 6:00 P.M. at Tan-Tar-A Lodge in Camden County.
- 2. That notice shall be given by the Records Department and the Information Officer of the Public Service Commission as set forth above.
