On May 3, 2005, Damon Anderson filed a complaint against AmerenUE. According to the complaint, Mr. Anderson is not responsible for Ericka Walters' bill. AmerenUE denies his allegations.

The Commission believes that appropriate input from the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission will assist in resolving this case. Therefore, the Commission will order Staff to investigate Mr. Anderson's allegations, and to report to the Commission.

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission will investigate the circumstances set out in the complaint and file a written report with the Commission, no later than July 6, 2005.

2. That Damon Anderson and Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, may respond to Staff's report no later than July 16, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on June 6, 2005.
