ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This case involves the 1992-93 actual cost adjustment filing of Laclede Gas Company, filed October 22, 1993. After audit, the Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation on July 29, 1994. On October 19, 1994, Laclede Gas Company filed its response to the Staff recommendation. A prehearing conference was held November 14, 1994, and, as a result, suggested procedural schedules were offered on January 4, 1995, and January 10, 1995, the most recent having revised dates.

The Staff's motion is granted and, by consent of the parties, the Commission adopts the following procedural schedule in this matter:

Laclede files direct testimony	January 27, 1995
Staff and other parties file rebuttal testimony	March 14, 1995
Laclede files surrebuttal testimony	May 12, 1995
Prehearing conference	September 8, 1995
Hearing Memorandum	September 22, 1995
Evidentiary hearing	October 10-11, 1995

All testimony and other appropriate documents will be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. on the date above specified.

The prehearing conference and evidentiary hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. on the dates specified and will be held at the offices of

the Public Service Commission, Harry S. Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Room 530, Jefferson City, Missouri.


