In the matter of the application of
Missouri Public Service Company, a
Missouri corporation, for authority
to increase the borrowing limits of
the Jeffrey Energy Center Trust from
\$30,000,000 to \$80,000,000 and to
convert the Trust to a revolving
credit/term loan agreement in the
amount of \$80,000,000.

ORDER DISMISSING CASE

On October 18, 1982, this Commission issued a Report and Order in the
above-styled case stating that the application of Missouri Public Service Company
(hereinafter referred to as Applicant) to increase the borrowing limits of the
Jeffrey Energy Center Trust from \$30,000,000 to \$80,000,000 was granted. The
Commission further stated that by subsequent order, it would determine the
applicability of the fee schedule pursuant to Section 386.300, RSMo 1978. A
Supplemental Order authorizing the Company's execution of the documents in
substantially final form in the above-styled case was issued on December 23, 1982.

The Applicant filed on April 27, 1983, a letter which stated that it had
not elected to increase the borrowing limits of the Jeffrey Energy Center Trust as
authorized in Case No. Ef-83-50 and, therefore, no proceeds were received by the
Company.

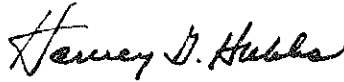
Since no financial transaction occurred, the Commission finds that the fee
schedule pursuant to Section 386.300, RSMo 1978, does not apply in this case and that
Case No. EF-83-50 should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Case No. EF-83-50 shall be, and is, hereby dismissed.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the 3rd day of
June, 1983.
