ORDER AND NOTICE

On November 5, 1985, Richard Fogelsong and William H. Hill, statutory  
trustees for Virginia Properties, Inc., formerly a Missouri Corporation filed their  
application to sell and transfer its franchise, works or system necessary and useful  
in the rendition of sewer treatment service to M.P.B. Inc. (MPB). MPB is a private  
corporation of the State of Missouri established and existing pursuant to  
Chapter 351, RSMo 1978. Pursuant to Section 393.190, RSMo 1978, a private  
corporation must receive authorization from this Commission before such a transfer  
can occur.

In the event no proper party or governmental entity files an application to  
intervene or a motion to schedule a hearing in this matter, the Commission will allow  
the Applicants to submit their application by verified statements.

Applications to intervene should be filed with the Secretary of the  
Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 and  
copies sent to John Howald, Attorney, One Thurman Court, Hillsboro, Missouri 63050  
and Cara L. Detring, Attorney, West First & South Jefferson, Farmington, Missouri  
63640 on or before December 5, 1985.

The Secretary of the Commission shall send notice of this Order to the members of the General Assembly representing the area served by Virginia Properties, Inc. and to the publisher of each newspaper located in the service area of the Company as listed in the Newspaper Directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri. The Secretary of the Commission shall serve a copy of this Order upon the presiding Commissioner of the County Commission of Jefferson County.

The statutory trustees for Virginia Properties, Inc., should send notice of the proposed sale and transfer to the affected customers by mail.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That any interested person or entity shall file its application to intervene or motion to schedule a hearing in this matter on or before December 5, 1985.

ORDERED: 2. That the following notice shall be sent to the Virginia Properties, Inc.'s affected customers on or before November 25, 1985:

By application, the statutory trustees for Virginia Properties, Inc., have requested the Missouri Public Service Commission to enter an order authorizing them to sell and transfer its franchise, works or system necessary and useful in the rendition of sewer treatment service to M.P.B. Inc.

Persons or entities desiring to formally participate in the case must file an application to intervene on or before December 5, 1985, with the Secretary of the Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 and send a copy to the Company's attorney, John Howald, One Thurman Court, Hillsboro, Missouri 63050 and M.P.B. Inc.'s attorney, Cara L. Detring, West First & South Jefferson, Farmington, Missouri 63640.

Article 1. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.


