## **QUARTERLY STATUS REPORT**

COMES NOW Lake Region Water and Sewer Company ("Lake Region" or "Company") and for this quarterly status report submits the following to the Commission:

1. The Company continues to take daily readings each day for the Parshall Flume and the associated water meters and forwarding those readings to Staff Engineer Martin Hummel periodically. Mr. Hummel continues to provide precipitation data to the Company.

2. The Company is investigating construction of a short sewer main to eliminate several metering points for flow from the hotel. Mr. Hummel visited the site with Company personnel on January 5, 2012 to assist in taking preliminary measurements and elevations. The Company is currently evaluating this scenario.

3. Once the Company has reviewed the preliminary measurements it will consider the feasibility of the short sewer main, and schedule another conference with the Company, Mr. Hummel and the customers to discuss and receive their input.
