STAFF STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its status report, states as follows:

1. On September 21, 2012, Boomerang Wireless, LLC (“the Company”), a wireless carrier, filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service fund support for low income customers through Lifeline and LinkUp programs.

2. As of this date, the Staff has not completed its review of the Company’s application. The Staff has outstanding Data Requests, which are now the Staff’s practice in all wireless ETC applications. In light of the press of other business, the Staff expects that it will be approximately some months before it can make its recommendation, but expects to do so on or before March 1, 2013. If the remaining inquiry can be completed more quickly, then the Staff will make its recommendation as soon as practicable thereafter.

WHEREFORE, the Staff submits its Status Report.
