ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO RELINQUISH ETC DESIGNATION

On March 17, 2014, Cricket Communications, Inc. filed a notice relinquishing its Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) designation under 47 U.S.C. §214(e)(4). Cricket asks that the Commission issue an order allowing the company to stop taking orders for new Lifeline service as of May 1, 2015, and to stop offering Lifeline service as July 31, 2015.

On April 3, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff informs the Commission that the company has satisfied the requirements of §214(e)(4) and that Lifeline customers can continue to receive service. Staff recommends that the Commission grant the company's request to be effective on July 31, 2015; an effective date requested by the company.

Based on the company's notice and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the requirements of §214(e)(4) have been satisfied and will grant the company's request to relinquish it ETC status.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

 Cricket Communications, Inc. may stop taking orders for new Lifeline service effective May 1, 2015.

- 2. Cricket Communication, Inc.'s relinquishment of its Eligible Telecommunications Carrier status is granted effective July 1, 2015.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on May 1, 2015.
 - 4. This file shall be closed on May 2, 2015.
