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**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its Response, states as follows:

1. On March 14, 2012, TAG Mobile, LLC f/k/a dPi Mobile, LLC (“the Company”) requested designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) for the purpose of receiving federal Universal Service Fund (“USF”) low-income support for Lifeline services.

2. On February 5, 2014, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved a Stipulation and Agreement between the Staff and the Company. The Company has paid the stipulated amount, has submitted and agreed to adhere to a compliance plan that will govern its future interaction with Lifeline Service customers in Missouri.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff recommends that the Company be granted ETC designation, on the condition that it continues to adhere to the compliance plan, as well as any other conditions in the Commission’s rules concerning the provision of wireless Lifeline Service to low-income customers.
