**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION  
FOR EXPANDED SERVICE AREA**

In May of 2013, the Commission granted an application to designate Boomerang Wireless, Inc. d/b/a enTouch Wireless as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier to provide service in certain areas in Missouri. On February 29, 2016, Boomerang filed an application to expand its service area to all exchanges in the State of Missouri. Attached to the company's application as Attachment A is a description of the expanded service area.

The Commission issued notice of the application, but there were no requests to intervene.

The Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation on March 15. Staff states that it is not aware of any reason why extending Boomerang's service area would be contrary to public interest.

The Commission has reviewed the company's verified application and Staff's recommendation and will grant the requested relief.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Boomerang Wireless, Inc. d/b/a enTouch Wireless' service area is expanded to include all exchanges in the State of Missouri.

2. This order shall become effective on April 16, 2016.
3. This file shall be closed on April 17, 2016.
