PROGRESS REPORT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE or Company), and hereby responds to the Missouri Public Service Commission's (Commission) *Order Directing Parties to File Progress Report*, issued on September 11, 2007. In this regard, AmerenUE states as follows:

1. On July 2, 2007, AmerenUE filed its proposed Industrial Demand Response (IDR) tariff with a 90-day effective date.
2. Since that filing, the Company has had several conversations with the Missouri Energy Group (MEG) in an attempt to develop a tariff that both parties find acceptable. The Company has kept all parties in this case informed of developments through email communications and telephone conversations. The parties participated in a conference call yesterday, September 18th, to discuss the latest proposal, which reflected terms that have been verbally agreed upon between AmerenUE and MEG.
3. Complete agreement does not yet exist, but progress has been made and the parties have agreed to exchange additional information. Another conference call has been scheduled for September 28th at 10:00 am.
4. The 90-day effective date of the July 2nd tariff filing is October 1, 2007. AmerenUE requests the Commission suspend the tariff until November 1, 2007, so that the parties can continue their discussions and work towards a joint resolution. The Company believes this suspension will be sufficient to determine whether or not an

agreement can be reached. Based upon previous discussions, AmerenUE feels that it will be able to reach an agreement with the majority of parties, if not with all parties. The Company will file either a second Progress Report or a revised tariff shortly after the September 28th meeting.

5. This Progress Report has been circulated to the parties in this case and while it is filed as an AmerenUE pleading, no party offered an objection to this report.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully requests the Commission accept this Progress Report in response to the Commission's order of September 11, 2007, and that the Commission suspend the tariff until November 1, 2007.
