By letter dated September 14, 1998, Union Electric Company documented the submission of a preliminary earnings report and a proposed sharing report to the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of Public counsel and the attorney for certain industrial customers. Those reports were prepared pursuant to the provisions of the Stipulation and Agreement submitted in Case No. ER-95-411. In addition, the Company submitted its calculation of "weather-normalized" data for determining the rate reduction called for in the Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. EM-96-149.

On October 13, 1998, the Company filed an original and fourteen copies of Union Electric Company" Final Earnings Report and Proposed sharing Report for the Third Sharing Period established by the Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. ER-95-411. That filing was made in Case No. EO-96-14. On November 24, 1998, the Company filed a Corrected Final Earnings and Sharing Report in EO-96-14. That filing corrected the October 13th filing, as more fully described in the November 24th cover letter. In neither of these filings, did the company submit a corrected version of the weather-normalized data for determining the rate reduction.
