COME NOW, Ag Processing, Inc., a cooperative, the Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company, and the Office of the Public Counsel (collectively the "Signatories") and for their Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule, respectfully state as follows:

1. On February 14, 2008, the Commission issued its Order Approving Tariff to Establish Rate Schedules for Fuel Adjustment Clause. On March 23, 2010, the Western District Court of Appeals issued its Opinion reversing the Commission's Order and remanding this matter for further proceedings.

2. In order to allow the Commission to consider the Western District's Opinion and determine the proper method to implement that decision, the Signatories propose the following procedural schedule:

Parties file Initial Pleadings / Briefs on the  
Meaning of the Court of Appeals Opinion and the  
Implications of that Decision

Parties file Reply Pleadings / Briefs in Response to Initial Pleadings

Oral Argument September 20, 2010

3. Depending on the Commission's decision on the threshold legal matters raised by the Parties in their pleadings, it may be necessary for the Commission to establish additional proceedings, including the possibility of evidentiary hearings, in order to consider any factual issues which may arise.

WHEREFORE, the Signatories respectfully request that the Commission adopt this Procedural Schedule for its consideration of this case.
