**ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR OBJECTIONS TO APPLICATION TO
INTERVENE**

On June 29, 2015 Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to operate solar generation facilities in Montgomery County, Missouri. The Commission issued an order setting a July 28 deadline for applications to intervene. On July 24, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy ("Division of Energy") filed an application to intervene.

The Commission will set a deadline for the filing of objections to Division of Energy's application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Objections to Division of Energy's application to intervene shall be filed no later than July 31, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
