ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The parties have jointly proposed a procedural schedule to resolve Staff's complaint against Cintex Wireless, LLC. The Commission will adopt the procedural schedule as proposed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

Parties submit briefs on what tariff, statute, rule, order, or decision within the Commission's jurisdiction was violated and the legal standards to be applied - **August 31, 2012**

Cut-off for propounding data requests - **September 14, 2012**

Motion filing deadline, deposition deadline (all depositions completed) - **September 21, 2012**

Direct testimony by both parties - **October 12, 2012**

Rebuttal testimony by both parties - **October 23, 2012**

Prehearing briefs, issues list, order

3. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:

A. The parties shall agree upon and Staff shall file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

B. All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

C. All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

D. By agreement of the parties, discovery shall be expedited to five days for objections and ten days for responses.

4. The hearing shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
