### **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On June 25, 2001, Union Electric, Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) filed an emergency motion requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission temporarily stay the expiration of the Second Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan (Second EARP). AmerenUE filed its entire pleading under seal as a proprietary document pursuant to the provisions of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.085 and the protective order previously issued in this case on December 13, 1995. AmerenUE did not file a public version of the pleading as required by the protective order and the rule. It appears that this document was not filed in compliance with the Commission's rule.

The Commission will direct AmerenUE to file an amended motion, identifying the proprietary information as directed in the Commission's protective order, and filing a public version of the document. Parties wishing to file an objection pursuant to the protective order may do so according to the protective order, beginning on the date that the amended pleading is filed.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE shall, no later than June 27, 2001, file an amended version of its motion filed on June 25, 2001, in compliance with the Commission's Rule and the Commission's protective order, identifying the proprietary information properly as directed in the Commission's protective order, and filing a public version of the document.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on June 27, 2001.
