**ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On April 6, 2001, Laclede Gas Company filed a motion requesting that the procedural schedule be modified. Laclede states that the parties to the case have had additional discussions and believe that an extension of the filing dates for testimony will facilitate settlement. Laclede states that all parties agree to this extension.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed modified procedural schedule and finds that it is reasonable to reconsider its previous procedural schedule. 
