ORDER FINDING NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

)

The Commission on its own motion has determined that a change to Chapter 4 of the Commission's rules is necessary so that the Commission may update and refine the standards of practice expected when parties appear before the Commission. Specifically, the Commission intends to revise its rules regarding gratuities, conduct during proceedings, and ex parte communications.

The Commission has authority to make procedural rules under Sections 386.040 and 386.410, RSMo 2000. Section 536.016, RSMo 2000, requires a state agency to find that a proposed rule is necessary to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the rulemaking authority based on substantial evidence on the record. Based on the record, the Commission finds that the proposed rescission, revision and repromulgation of Chapter 4 of the Commission's rules is necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 386.040 and 386.410, RSMo 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Commission will proceed to make the rescission, revision and repromulgation of Chapter 4 of the Commission's rules, by following the applicable procedures of administrative rulemaking with the Missouri Secretary of State's Office.

2. That this order will become effective on September 28, 2001.
