### ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On July 9, 2001, the City of Hannibal, Missouri, and Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Ralls County, Missouri, filed their joint application for approval by the Missouri Public Service Commission under Section 247.172, RSMo 2000, of a territorial agreement setting out the boundaries of their respective water service areas. The City is located in Ralls and Marion Counties, Missouri, and provides water service to its residents. The District is located in Ralls County, Missouri, and provides water service to persons residing in both Ralls and Marion Counties, Missouri.

The Commission is required to determine this matter no later than the 120<sup>th</sup> day following the filing of the application. Therefore, the Commission will move expeditiously to bring this matter to a resolution. The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed 20 days from the effective date of this order to file a motion for leave to intervene. The Commission determines that notice of this Application should be given by the Commission's Records Department to the County Commission of Ralls County, Missouri, and of Marion County, Missouri. The Commission further determines that the Information Officer of the Commission should provide notice of this Application to the members of the

General Assembly representing the residents of Ralls and Marion Counties and to the newspapers and other media which serve those counties.

The Commission is required to determine this matter after hearing.<sup>1</sup> However, the requirement of a hearing is met when an opportunity to be heard has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence.<sup>2</sup> If there are no requests for a hearing, relief may be granted based on the verified petition.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Records Department of the Commission shall send notice of this Application to the County Commission of Ralls County, Missouri, and to the County Commission of Marion County, Missouri.
- 2. That the Information Officer of the Commission shall provide notice of this Application to the members of the General Assembly representing persons residing within Ralls County and Marion County, Missouri, and to the newspapers and other media which serve those counties.
- 3. That any party wishing to intervene or request a hearing in this matter shall file an application no later than August 6, 2001, with:
