- 2. On April 25, 2005, the Staff filed a Status Report, in which it stated that it planned to file its recommendation in this case by May 31, 2005.

The Staff is not able to file its recommendation by May 31, as planned, because the Company has not yet submitted an application to the Missouri Department of Natural Resource, Kansas City Regional Office, for construction and operating permits for the facilities that will be needed to provide sewer service. Willis Sherry, president of the Company, told the Staff that the Company's engineer will submit the said applications to the Department of Natural Resources on Tuesday, May 31, 2005.

- 4. There are no customers awaiting service in the area that the Company proposes to serve, and Staff has been informed that no homes will be constructed in the proposed service territory until the fall of this year, at the earliest.
- 5. The Staff therefore requests the time for filing the Staff Recommendation in this case be extended by 30 days, to June 30, 2005.
