On December 22, 2011, T-Mobile Central LLC ("T-Mobile") requested designation by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of providing low income-related services, including Lifeline service, to qualifying low-income consumers within its service area in Missouri. On May 1, 2012, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation advising the Commission to deny T-Mobile's application. T-Mobile filed a response to the staff recommendation on May 10, 2012, in which T-Mobile stated that, contrary to Staff's assertions, statements in its application and subsequent amendment were true and granting the application would be in the public interest. The Commission will direct Staff to file a response to T-Mobile's pleading filed May 10, 2012 titled *Response to Staff Recommendation to Deny Application*.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file a response to T-Mobile's pleading titled *Response to Staff Recommendation to Deny Application* no later than May 18, 2012, stating in detail why Staff agrees or disagrees with T-Mobile's assertions. 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
