**ORDER CANCELING ELIGIBLE
TELECOMMUNICATION CARRIER DESIGNATION**

Effective Date: June 15, 2015

On May 20, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Cancel Designation. Staff states that Aegis Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Off The Hook Telecom filed a request to relinquish its Eligible Telecommunication Carrier (“ETC”) designation. Staff agrees with Off The Hook that Off The Hook meets all the federal requirements to relinquish its designation, and that Off The Hook no longer provides Lifeline service in Missouri.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) gives parties ten days to respond to pleadings. No party responded within ten days.

The Commission will grant Staff’s motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Cancel Designation by the Staff of the Commission is granted.
2. The designation of Aegis Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Off The Hook Telecom as an Eligible Telecommunication Carrier is cancelled.

3. This order shall be effective on June 15, 2015.
4. This file shall be closed on June 16, 2015.
