ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT REGARDING MOTION TO PROVISIONALLY REVOKE CINTEX'S ETC DESIGNATION

The Commission's Staff has filed a complaint against Cintex Wireless, LLC, and Cintex has filed its answer to that complaint. Along with its complaint, Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to provisionally revoke Cintex's ETC designation during the pendency of its complaint. The Commission directed Cintex to show cause why its ETC designation should not be revoked. Cintex responded with a written argument and a request to present oral argument in opposition to a provisional revocation.

The Commission will grant Cintex's request for oral argument and will schedule that argument for the time previously set for a prehearing conference. The prehearing conference will proceed following the oral argument.
